# A NATURAL AND CULTURAL HERITAGE

The valley offers you the pleasure of escape, entertainment and relaxation in an area combining the commune of Aragnouet and its various hamlets, the Néouvielle National Nature Reserve and the Piau-Engaly resort.

Bordered by the Badet valley, which leads to the lake of the same name, Piau-Engaly enjoys a strategic position for holidaymakers in search of wide open spaces and breathtaking scenery.

On the other side of the river, the heart of the Pyrenees National Park begins, which can be reached directly on foot from the resort. Piau-Engaly is a privileged gateway for admiring its remarkable, well-preserved flora and fauna.

Its neighbour, the famous and fabulous Néouvielle Nature Reserve, also classified as a Grands Sites d'Occitanie (Great Sites of Occitania), unfurls its landscapes in all their beauty. Its hooked pines, which beat altitude longevity records here, its beds of

rhododendrons, and the blue waters of its lakes, offer a breathtaking range of landscapes. blue waters of its lakes, offer walkers an absolutely splendid and protected walking area. In this granite environment shaped by glaciers, the fauna and flora are also exceptionally rich, ranging from ridges over 3000m, lakes, meadows and pine forests. Nestling at the end of the Haute-Vallée d'Aure, Piau-Engaly is the last resort at the foot of the French side of the Pyrenees. On the other side of the border is Spain and its region of Aragon, where nature takes on other forms of beauty. The vertiginous cliffs

of the Ordesa-Mont Perdu National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site, are breathtaking. The Añisclo canyon, which winds its way through the park and is so deep in places that you can't even see it, winds its way between waterfalls and lush forest.



# MARKED CIRCUITS

TO MAKE THE MOST OF THE MOUNTAINS IN COMPLETE SAFETY, A NUMBER OF HIKING TRAILS HAVE BEEN MARKED FROM PIAU-ENGALY.

To reach them, take the **Campbielh chairlift** to one of the resort's highest points, at 2200m. From there, choose one of the four signposted trails. Depending on your level of ability, the trails are ideal for leisurely or contemplative family strolls from the panoramic viewpoint. The more adventurous can set off on the Barroude path, which leads down to the La Gela valley for a full day's hiking. A shuttle bus will take you back to the resort (please book in advance).

A visit to the Tourist Office is always a good opportunity to remind you to take care in the mountains, even in summer!









The Badet Valley is a treasure trove of unspoilt nature, hiding and protecting a biotope of exceptional flora and fauna. Open your eyes and your heart and you'll see it all! My favourite spot for families is the adorable little Badet lake. Along the way, the playful marmots accompany the walkers.

Take time to meet Elsa, Michaël and their son at the shepherd's hut. This is where they rear a magnificent flock of black-headed Manech ewes. They transform their milk into a delicious cheese. A gourmet break is a must!

### THE NEOUVIELLE NATIONAL NATURE RESERVE

#### IN THE LAND OF 1000 LAKES...

Or almost! **The massif is an** exceptional site, rich in landscapes and wild flora and

**fauna**, such as the hooked pines that grow at record altitudes. Nature lovers will find it a real paradise. The gateway to a multitude of hikes, you'll find refuges, a reception and exhibition centre, restaurants and bivouac sites.

The site welcomes a large number of visitors every summer season, and is constantly developing new facilities to make it easier to access the site while respecting its fragile yet grandiose environment.

### LAKES OF CAP-DE-LONG AND OREDON

THE NÉOUVIELLE NATIONAL NATURE RESERVE INCLUDES TWO MAJESTIC LAKES IN THE COMMUNE OF ARAGNOUET, TO WHICH PIAU-ENGALY BELONGS: ORÉDON AND CAP-DE-LONG.

To reach them, we set off from Fabian, a small hamlet also attached to the commune of Aragnouet. The D929, which winds its way up to the top of the mountain, is aptly named the "Lakes Route". It leads as far as the first lake at Orédon, where a picnic by its bewitching, crystal-clear, turquoise blue waters is a must.

Further west, the route continues to Cap-de-Long lake, which is accessible by car. This glacial lake covers 110 hectares, making it the second largest water reserve in the Pyrenees. We're here at an altitude of 2160 m, on the edge of the Pyrenees National Park.

In the evening, when the last hikers return to the valley, you can bivouac in the Néouvielle National Nature Reserve from 7pm until 9am. There are specific, marked areas near Lac d'Orédon and Lac d'Aubert. Fires are strictly forbidden. An unforgettable night under the stars.

# FABIAN BIKE CENTER

At Aragnouet, the mountain bike route from the Couéou forest leads through a pastoral area to the Moudang Bridge.

The wide Flow-Trail track, with no major difficulties, is ideal for beginners with moderate gradients and sharp bends. Intermediates and experts will also find something to suit them on the other enduro trails and the green to black pumptrack loops.

#### + ZIPLINES VALLEY

The ziplines valley is a course of 6 wooden ziplines linked together. Installed in the Discovery Garden, the 150m-long course passes from suspended workshop to suspended workshop, 1m above the ground. The activity is supervised by station staff. There's no risk involved as you soar through the air like Tarzan!

#### **+ TRANSHUMANCE WALK**

From the resort, Patrice, an emblematic, picturesque and generous breeder based in Vignec, a village a little further down the valley, takes us as far as Badet lake.

This is where his Limousin cows graze in summer. It's a very easy, family-friendly walk that introduces us to his profession and the mountain ecosystem where Patrice lives and works. Once you arrive at the lake, you can sample the farm's produce, a real treat for restoring your strength!

#### **+** WHITE WATER SPORTS

On the Neste, or further downstream on the plain, gorges and streams offer a variety of playgrounds. Here you can enjoy a range of water sports on inflatable craft, rafting, hydrospeed and airboat.

On the other side of the border, there are water treks and canyoning courses for families (from age 7), discovery (from age 10), sports and rope canyoning (from age 15).





# **NOUDANG** BRIDGE

Are you looking for peace and quiet and a fun place for the kids to play? Then the Site du Moudang is for you!

#### **+** THE MOUDANG BARNS

The Moudang play area, with its picnic area under the trees, interpretation trail, play area and insect hotel, is a popular spot for families and is accessible to people with reduced mobility. The walk along the Neste du Moudang leads to a series of barns on a plateau at an altitude of 1,500 metres (approx. 2.5 hours). They bear witness to the pastoral activity of yesteryear. If you still have some energy left, continue on to the ferruginous spring, a 30-minute walk away. Our furry friends are not allowed, even on a lead.

#### + THEMED FOREST TRAIL WITH DISABLED ACCESS

This trail is built around interpretation panels: an audio terminal with bird songs, moulded footprints, a silhouette in relief, the scents of the forest and the music of the wood.



Situated in the heart of nature at the start of all these activities. **Services included**: electricity, drainage, water, wifi, video surveillance

#### + ADVENTURE TRAIL

In the heart of the gorges and lush countryside, take off on an adventure on the **green to black courses**, zip lines, monkey bridges and Tarzan jump for a sensational half-day activity.

#### + CHILDREN'S PLAY AREA

Access for children aged 2-6 and 6-12 (monkey bridges, climbing rope, slide, etc.)

+ **Multi activities area** (football pitch, handball, basketball).

# A PLACE OF ART AND HISTORY

#### A HERITAGE TO (RE)DISCOVER

Since 2008, the Aure valley has had the Pays d'Art et d'Histoire label, and Piau-Engaly is no exception. Guides from the Pays d'Art et d'Histoire offer guided tours of this rich heritage throughout the year.

#### The Templar chapel

NASTO

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Located in the hamlet of Le Plan, in Aragnouet, the Chapelle des Templiers is a building dating back to the 12<sup>th</sup> century. The former hospice, with its typical Romanesque architecture, was run by the monks of the Order of St John of Jerusalem to welcome pilgrims and cross-border travellers. It is assumed that it also served as a stopover for pilgrims on their way to Santiago de Compostela. Next to the chapel was the hospice, most of which did not stand the test of time and fell into the ravine. Only one large gable remains, with four arches for the bells. At its foot is the cemetery enclosure.

The Templars' chapel is now listed and protected by UNESCO. Bordered by the flowing waters of the Neste d'Aure, its silhouette stands out against the green backdrop of slopes stretching to the foot of peaks each higher than the next. It's a picture postcard to capture on film!

Eget my beautiful village: "Situated at an altitude of 1100m in the commune of Aragnouet, Eget is more than just a village, it's a haven of peace and calm, with its beautiful cobbled streets. Set on a rocky outcrop, it dominates the gorges above the Neste d'Aure. I recommend a visit to its parish church, Saint Pierre aux Liens (12th century), which has undergone several alterations. In 2016, the restoration of its listed altarpiece revealed some exceptional wall paintings. Eget is also the starting point for a lovely loop trail, the "sentier du Bédat, chemin de l'Auria" (3h).

Follow the "Sentier Transfrontalier" signs to the village of Cadeilhan-Trachère, which passes through the Auroise barns and offers pleasant views of the hilltop villages, as well as traditional palombières. The GR 105, which follows in the footsteps of the pilgrims to Santiago de

Compostela, takes you back to the starting point.

#### **+ VIGNECOISE FARM**

Theme outings with the Vignecoise Farm, a transhumance walk on one morning a week during the summer season, accompanied by a local breeder.

You'll be provided with a picnic hamper (for a fee) made with produce from his farm.Your taste buds will be delighted to savour these local products at over 2000m altitude!

#### + MIELLERIE D'AURE

Julien's bee farm is located in Aragnouet, in the Pyrenees National Park. Its honeys are harvested from wild flowers and mainly in the mountains, at altitudes of between 700 and 2200m.

Certified organic since 2010, the honey house has around 200 hives, populated with local strains of bees known as «black bees», and run with the well-being of the bee colonies and the low-yield production of top-quality honeys as top priorities. In summer, visits are organised to two markets.

Every year, Piau plays host to two race starts for the Grand Raid des Pyrénées, one of the Aure valley's flagship events. It's renowned the world over! Join us on 22 August for the **Tour de la Géla** (a 40km race with a height difference of 3,400m) and the **Tour du Moudang** (a 60km race with a height difference of 3,600m).

The following day, 23 August, for the start of the **Tour des Cirques**, a 120km race with a height difference of 7,000m.
