Tucked between the Aure Valley, the Spanish border, and the natural wonders of the Pyrenees National Park and the Néouvielle Nature Reserve, Piau unfolds a jaw-dropping landscape of sharp ridges, 3000-meter peaks, high-altitude pine forests, hidden valleys, and sparkling lakes.

Cradled by the Badet Valley and just steps from the heart of the **NATIONAL PARK**, the resort is the perfect launchpad for exploring wide-open spaces. No gimmicks here — just raw, untouched nature that feels real and close.

It's the kind of place that recharges your batteries and slows down time, with scenic hikes, peaceful moments, wildlife encounters, and bursts of colorful mountain flora.

Whether you're curious to experience a slower pace, an unstoppable hiker, a parent looking for fun family moments, or simply craving quiet and awe, Piau is your refuge. Every day brings a fresh breath of air, every trail is a new adventure waiting to happen.






Hiker's and Trail Runner's PARADSE

With countless trails starting right from the resort, the top of the Campbielh chairlift, or the Néouvielle Nature Reserve, Piau is an absolute dream for hiking and trail running. Whether you're a chill stroller, a seasoned athlete, going solo or with the fam, this place is one epic playground.









Now throw in a fresh mountain climate, a laid-back, family-friendly vibe, and the perfect atmosphere to recharge... and you've got yourself the ultimate getaway to escape the everyday and breathe deep.

A summer favorite? The **MTB ZONES OPENED IN 2024** are back and going strong. Easily accessible from the resort, they offer routes for all levels, from scenic descents to forest trails. The Campbielh chairlift makes it a breeze to reach the starting points — both for mountain biking and the well-marked hiking trails up top.

A shuttle is still available for an easy return from beautiful loops out to the Barroude lakes and the Géla Valley.

NEW THIS SEASON — THE VENTRIGLISSE! This fun slide attraction, set up next to the beginners' carpet lift, is included with the MARMOTTON PASS (€7.50 for unlimited daily access). The pass also includes the ADVENTURE COURSE and the MTB initiation zone.

And of course, our **THEMED STAYS** are still a hit: from family adventures and guided workshops to discovering pastoral traditions or diving into nature immersion — it's a gentle, local way to experience the mountains differently.







Well, almost! The Néouvielle massif is a truly special place, bursting with wild landscapes, rich biodiversity, and natural charm. Here, mountain pines grow at recordbreaking altitudes, and lakes glitter as far as the eye can see — it's a paradise for nature lovers. Refuges, visitor centers, local eateries, and designated bivouac areas are dotted across this **GRAND SITE OCCITANIE**, designed to offer immersive experiences while preserving its beauty.

From Piau, it's easy to reach some of the most iconic routes via the scenic Route des Lacs. There's the **LAQUETTES** walk, easy and accessible for everyone, the lakeside loop around **ORÉDON LAKE** for a cool break by the water, or the ascent to the stunning **AUMAR AND AUBERT LAKES** — either on foot or by summer shuttle. Further west, the glacial **CAP-DE-LONG LAKE** stuns with its vast expanse at over 2.100 meters above sea level.

As evening falls and the trails quiet down, some adventurers choose to extend their stay at the top, setting up camp in authorized bivouac zones.







This summer, get ready for an unforgettable MTB experience, thanks to all the awesome trail setups in Piau and the surrounding valley!

From the resort, you've got several options to hit the trails: A PANORAMIC DOWNHILL RIDE FROM THE TOP OF CAMPBIELH, a multi-wheel track that's perfect for mountain bikes or offroad scooters, and an uphill route specially designed for e-bikes.

Whether you're a beginner or a seasoned rider, you'll find your groove in this untouched natural setting.

The **PIAU BIKE CENTER** now stretches all the way to the Couéou forest, connected via a new trail to the **FABIAN BIKE CENTER**. Tucked away in the wild, the Fabian spot offers forest trails shaped for all skill levels — from beginners to pros.




The **COUÉOU-TO-PONT DU MOUDANG ROUTE**, with its wide, flowy trails and gentle slopes with banked turns, is ideal for getting started with downhill riding.

More advanced riders will love the enduro lines, too. It's a welcoming hub for bikers looking for both thrill and authenticity.

And to make things easier (and greener), a shuttle brings you back from the *Pont du Moudang* to the resort.

THE GRANGES DU MOUDANG

HIKE is a must-do. Starting from the welcome area, a peaceful trail winds up the valley to a plateau dotted with old pastoral barns at 1500 meters altitude. Along the way, you'll pass lush alpine flora, a babbling stream, and an interpretive zone with fun facts about the area. For the curious, a 30-minute detour takes you to a historic iron-rich spring. (Note: Dogs not allowed, even on a leash.)

THE MOUDANG CAMPER VAN

AREA is a true oasis for vanlifers — shaded, quiet, and right by the river. It offers electricity, water, waste disposal, Wi-Fi, and video surveillance — all just steps from the starting points of your next adventure.

And for a dose of thrills, check out the **PONT DU MOUDANG ADVENTURE COURSE!** Somewhere between via ferrata and treetop climbing, this high-up route dives into a lush gorge landscape.

Zip lines, monkey bridges, vertical nets, and a Tarzan swing make this one-of-a-kind course an unforgettable mix of rock, trees, and adrenaline. Perfect for daring little explorers and seasoned adventurers alike.









Since 2008, THE AURE VALLEY HAS BEEN RECOGNIZED AS A "LAND OF ART AND HISTORY" — and Piau-Engaly is part of the story. Here, heritage is out in the open, revealed through Romanesque chapels, hilltop villages, and ancient transhumance trails.

One gem not to miss: **THE TEMPLAR CHAPEL IN ARAGNOUET**, a 12th-century
Romanesque site listed by UNESCO. Once
a hospice for pilgrims, it still watches over
travelers today, standing tall between sky
and mountains. Guided tours are offered all
summer by official "Land of Art and History"
quidese.

Not far from there, **THE VILLAGE OF EGET**, perched on its rocky outcrop, reveals cobbled lanes and the Church of Saint-Pierre-aux-Liens, whose restored altarpiece boasts beautiful frescoes. It's also the starting point of a cross-border trail leading to Cadeilhan-Trachère and the traditional barns of the Aure region.

While Piau faces northward, it's also wide open to the south. **THE ARAGNOUET-BIELSA TUNNEL** links the valley to Spanish Aragón.

A breathtaking journey into the **SOBRARBE** region, dotted with charming villages and home to the **ORDESA-MONTE PERDIDO NATIONAL PARK**, another UNESCO World Heritage Site.


